

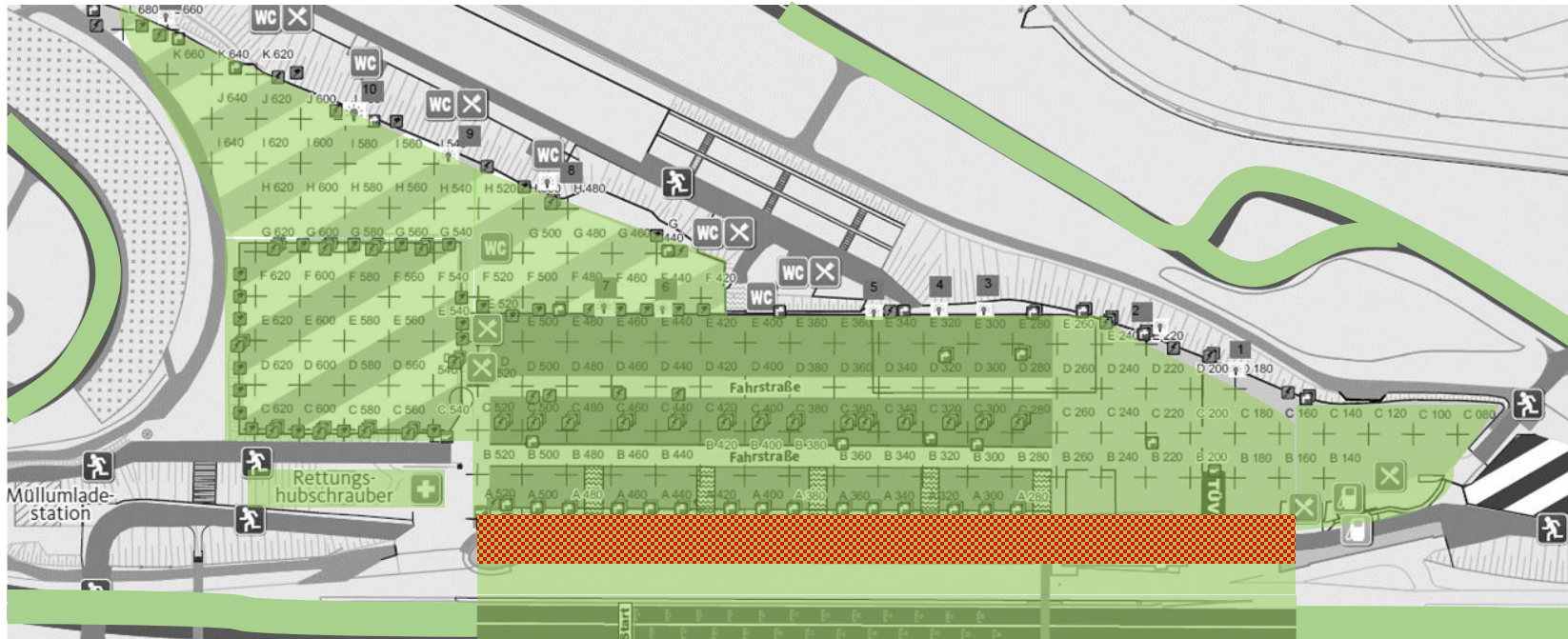


Nürburgring Endurance Series in times of the coronavirus pandemic **Version 2, 04 April 2022**



Division of event area into zones:

- The event area will be divided into two different zones :
 - **Red zone:** Offices, e.g. start and finish building, document collection, media center
⇒ mouth and nose protection: face masks mandatory (at least disposable medical mask)
 - **Green zone:** Pits, pit lane building, grid, marshals, race track
⇒ mouth and nose protection : If distance requirements cannot be observed, wearing a mask is recommended!



Execution of the event:

- The current Rhineland-Palatinate Corona Control Ordinance (33rd CoBeLVO) no longer stipulates any restrictions on events from April 3rd.
- Due to the currently high incidence, masks are still required in the offices of the pit building, e.g. in the start and finish building, document collection and media center. Please also pass this information on to your team members, guests or other persons!
- Proof of COVID-19 no longer has to be provided!

Ticket accreditation:

- Forwarding of lists of participants to teilnehmerliste@vln.de is no longer necessary!
- The ticketing process will remain digital in the future: the detailed procedure can be found in the following point.

Ticketing Teams:

- All teams receive an access link to the digital ticket system. This link is valid all year round.
- The free ticket contingent is stored in this ticket system depending on the number of entries. Before each event, this will be adjusted accordingly after the entry deadline on Monday afternoon. As soon as the VLN VV has made changes in the ticket system, the respective team representative will receive a notification via e-mail.
- All tickets are provided with a continuous number. Although this is not an obligation, the name can be changed by clicking on it once, e.g. "Veranstaltungsticket Team 1". The e-mail address can also be changed using the same principle. The name of the ticket holder can be changed multiple times, but the QR code remains the same and can only be used for one person.
- The ticket can then be created under "Ticket generieren". You now have the option of downloading the ticket or sending it to the specified e-mail address.
- If additional guest tickets are required, they can be ordered for a fee under "Weitere Tickets bestellen". After selecting the event and specifying the desired number of tickets, click on the "Speichern und kostenpflichtig bestellen" button. The ordered tickets are now stored in the general overview. If further team tickets are required, please contact the VLN VV (Jacqueline Johann | johann@vln.de).
- Annual tickets by registration: Free annual tickets that are included in a team/applicant annual registration are shown as annual guest tickets. This is a QR code that is valid all year round. However, the name can be changed before each event. The annual tickets can be found in the selection menu at the top right under "„2022-01-01 – Jahrestickets“".
- In order to ensure a smooth process, we ask you to set your mobile phone's screen to maximum brightness. If the display has cracks, it is advisable to print out the ticket, otherwise the scanner will not be able to read it!
- **Access tickets are only required on Saturday! There are no personal access controls on Thursday and Friday!**

Ticketing industry representatives:

- All annual industry tickets are now activated without restrictions.
- In addition, all industry representatives will receive an access link to the digital ticket system. This link is valid all year round.
- Guest and industry tickets for the respective racing event can be ordered for a fee under the aforementioned access link via "Weitere Tickets bestellen". After selecting the event and specifying the desired number of tickets, click on the "Speichern und kostenpflichtig bestellen" button. The ordered tickets are now stored in the general overview.
- All tickets are provided with a continuous number. Although this is not an obligation, the name can be changed by clicking on the name once, e.g. "Veranstaltungsticket Industrie 1". The e-mail address can also be changed using the same principle. The name of the ticket holder can be changed multiple times, but the QR code remains the same and can only be used for one person.
- The ticket can then be created under "Ticket generieren". You now have the option of downloading the ticket or sending it to the specified e-mail address.
- In order to ensure a smooth process, we ask you to set your mobile phone's screen to maximum brightness. If the display has cracks, it is advisable to print out the ticket, otherwise the scanner will not be able to read it!
- **Access tickets are only required on Saturday! There are no personal access controls on Thursday and Friday!**

Ticketing sponsors & partners:

- All sponsors and partners will receive an access link to the digital ticket system. This link is valid all year round.
- The contractually stipulated free ticket contingent can be viewed under "Hinweise". Annual tickets have already been created and can be found in the selection menu at the top right under "„2022-01-01 – Jahrestickets“".
- Event tickets, in turn, can be ordered under "Weitere Tickets bestellen". After selecting the event and specifying the desired number of tickets, click on the "Speichern und kostenpflichtig bestellen" button. The ordered tickets are now stored in the general overview. The free contingent will be offset against the ticket orders after the season and, if necessary, an invoice will be issued for the difference.
- All tickets are provided with a continuous number. By clicking on the name once, e.g. "Veranstaltungsticket Gast 1", the name can be changed, this is however no obligation. The e-mail address can also be changed using the same principle. The name of the ticket holder can be changed multiple times, but the QR code remains the same and can only be used for one person.
- The ticket can then be created under "Ticket generieren". You now have the option of downloading the ticket or sending it to the specified e-mail address.
- In order to ensure a smooth process, we ask you to set your mobile phone's screen to maximum brightness. If the display has cracks, it is advisable to print out the ticket, otherwise the scanner will not be able to read it!
- **Access tickets are only required on Saturday! There are no personal access controls on Thursday and Friday!**

Spectators:

- Spectators can obtain tickets on the Nürburgring website, the Nürburgring info°center and at the open box offices
- A ticket includes the following components :
 - ✓ Access to all open grandstands T3, T4, T12a
 - ✓ Access to the paddock
 - ✓ Access to Pit Walk & Grid Walk
 - ✓ Access to exclusive sub-areas trackside at Brunnchen and Pflanzgarten
 - ✓ Parking in the parking lots at Brunnchen (P96), Pflanzgarten (P98) and the „Hatzenbach-Plateau“ at the Sabine-Schmitz-curve
⇒ As in 2021, these parking lots are available only for ticket holders.
 - ✓ Access to the ring°werk
- Camping: Parking lot P96 is available to campers with motorhomes (NLS ticket required) | Flat-rate 35 € (Friday-Sunday)

Behavior in the event of symptoms of illness :

- The measures to comply with the current Corona Control Ordinance and the Corona regulations of the VLN must be observed. If symptoms of illness such as cough, fever, etc. should arrive on site, Mr. Armin Link (Medical Operations Manager, Medical Center) should be contacted on 02691 302 380. If you are generally feeling unwell or have a cold, you should refrain from participating in the event. A personal appearance at the Medical Center is urgently to be avoided! The organizer and the operator are entitled to exclude persons with recognizable respiratory infections from further participation in the event. If a corona case is confirmed, this must be reported to the team and the organizer immediately!
