



VISITOR-REGULATIONS

The purchase of a ticket for entry to the event site (hereinafter referred to as premises) of Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG shall imply acceptance of the following terms and conditions according to which Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG grants access to the premises and events.

A. ADMISSION TICKETS

1. Every visitor has to be in possession of a valid admission ticket. Entering the Nürburgring premises without a valid ticket is liable to prosecution and will lead to your immediate removal from our premises.
2. Resale of tickets is strictly forbidden. If a ticket is sold or handed on for profit-oriented or commercial reasons (also as part of an advertising campaign or as prize) without the express consent of Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG the ticket will become invalid and the holder can be refused access to or will be expelled from the premises.
3. Tickets are valid for the expressly stated stands only; RFID-tickets are valid according to their electronic coding. Tickets do not entitle the visitor to fixed seats or a certain standing room, if no fixed seat has been assigned to the visitor.
4. Tickets shall remain valid if the event is rescheduled due to reasons the organizer cannot be held responsible for. Tickets are not refundable.
5. Amounts cannot be reclaimed in case the event is aborted unless the event has not yet taken place to a significant extent. If the visitor is entitled to partial refund, Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG shall determine the rate at its reasonable discretion.
6. Any kind of claim concerning the refund of entrance fees has to be asserted in writing within a preclusion period of six months, starting on expiry of the final day of the event. All claims shall be time barred six months after their assertion in writing.
7. Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG uses an electronic control system to regulate access to the stands. Please take care to properly scan your ticket at the exit in order to guarantee a later re-entry without any problems.
8. Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG employs CCTV cameras for securing the premises. You consent to the use of any photo material containing any image of you which will be produced for general security purposes. Moreover you shall also agree on Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG using the CCTV photo material in any legal case or handing over the material to the police.
9. You are not allowed to produce, store, record or transmit any kind of audio, photo or audio-visual material (hereinafter referred to as recordings) of, during or in connection with the event. Furthermore, you are not allowed to store, record or transmit any information and data, including but not limited to official time measurements, results, performances, telemetry, weather or data of the race management. Any kind of equipment suitable to perform the aforementioned actions is forbidden on the premises. Unless otherwise stated, private electronic equipment (including cameras, mobile phones and other portable devices for private communication) is allowed on the premises. Provided that any recordings, data and any photo material, including photos and any kind of freeze frames which can be produced from the recordings of the event that were taken, stored and/or produced after the event, will only be used for personal, private and not for commercial purposes.
10. By entering the premises you agree that: a) the use of the aforementioned recordings, data and photos for any kind of public advertising, exhibition, commercial profit or any other purpose (except private use) is strictly forbidden without the prior written consent of Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG and shall be regarded as breach of terms and conditions for which you may be held liable and b) if so requested by Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG, you shall assign in writing the exclusive right of use and any intellectual property rights regarding any photo material or recordings you have produced, created, stored or recorded of, during or in connection with the event to Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG.
11. If capacity restrictions are required by the authorities at short notice, the "first come, first serve" policy will apply - tickets will be assigned according to the date of booking. In this case, spectators who are affected will be informed in advance about the ticket refund.

B. SAFETY & STANDS

1. Walkways and stairs on stands are to be kept free for safety reasons.
2. Depending on the stands' utilization, visitors can be instructed to remain standing. In this way sufficient view to the event is offered to other visitors who, like you, have purchased a ticket.
3. Instructions of the race management, marshals and staff at the barriers are to be followed. Violations will be regarded as trespassing.
4. Apart from seat cushions, no bulky items are allowed on the stands.
5. Do not cross existing safety installations! Otherwise you will place yourself and others in danger!
6. Naked flame and the firing of pyrotechnical items (such as rockets, fireworks, Bengal fireworks etc.) are strictly forbidden. Otherwise you will place other visitors, and not at last yourself, in great danger.
7. Weapons and items similar to weapons must not be taken to Nürburgring premises.
8. It is forbidden to bring animals to the premises. Dogs, if kept on a leash, are excepted from this rule.
9. You are not allowed to bring your own food and beverages to the stands or the paddock.
10. Parts of the areas are monitored by video cameras. This video surveillance of the premises is to enhance security, ensure that the rights of the premises' owner are observed, and that offences are prevented or investigated. The monitored areas are marked with a sign.

C. PROTECTION & HYGIENE

The Covid regulations of the respective current "Corona Bekämpfungsverordnung des Landes Rheinland-Pfalz" are valid.

D. ENVIRONMENT

Please take your litter to the litter bins provided for on the premise and take care to separate the litter as pictured on the bins.

E. LIABILITY

You acknowledge that racing, this event and certain activities connected therewith (including, but not limited to general events) are dangerous. Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG, authorising authorities and any persons engaged in the organization of the event (including officially employed persons, marshals as well as rescue and medical personnel), competitors and drivers (this group shall also cover, as far as relevant, any managing directors, directors, employees, representatives, suppliers and associated companies) are not responsible for any loss or damage suffered by you or your property. This shall apply for loss or damage to the maximum admissible amount according to German Law (this provision shall not limit or exclude (i) liability for death or injuries due to negligence by one of the aforementioned groups or (ii) any loss arising from fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation by the aforementioned groups. In return, Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG contracts a visitors' accident insurance in favour of the holder covering damages caused by vehicles during qualifying's and races.

F. FIRST AID
