



PARKING AND TEMPORARY CAMPING SITE REGULATIONS

DEAR GUESTS,

The Nürburgring opens certain parking areas for use as camping sites at various events. The areas are opened by Nürburgring security staff. Guests are required to observe the following parking and temporary camping site regulations:

- § 1 Guests comply with these parking and temporary camping site regulations when entering a parking or camping site.
- § 2 The regulations and signs of the German highway code (StVO) and road traffic licensing regulations (StVZO) apply on the site incl. the access and service roads. The roads may only be used for travel to and from the site. The maximum speed allowed on these roads is 10 km/h. The Nürburgring reserves the right to not let enter certain vehicles because of their weight or lengths.
- § 3 On the entire premises, starting, flyovers and landing of drones and similar objects is permitted only after prior consultation with and a special permit from the Nürburgring and the relevant authority. This provision applies to drones that require a licence as well as to those that may be operated without one, and also to all other kinds of flying objects. Violations will be prosecuted.
- § 4 Nürburgring assumes no liability for personal injury and material damage, irrespective of whether this is based on contractual or statutory regulations. This exclusion does not apply for damages from injury to life, body or health based on a deliberate or negligent breach of duty – including that of a statutory representative or vicarious agent of the persons released from liability – and not for any other damage based on a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of duty of a statutory or vicarious agent of the persons released from liability.
- § 5 Parked vehicles will not be guarded. You should thus make sure that the doors, boot, windows and sunroof are closed before leaving your vehicle, and that you do not leave any items in the vehicle. We would also ask you not to leave animals in your car. To counter theft, Nürburgring reserves the right to check random parking receipts for correctness upon departure.
- § 6 Parts of the parking and camping grounds are monitored by video cameras. This video surveillance of the premises is to enhance security, ensure that the rights of the premises' owner are observed, and that offences are prevented or investigated. The monitored areas are marked with a sign.
- § 7 Nürburgring is not liable for any theft or damage to your vehicle by third parties. This also applies if the damage is due to storm, fire, hailstones, explosions and other unusual events.
- § 8 Parking – where permitted – is subject to a fee. Those who fail to comply with this obligation are liable to prosecution. A separate fee will be charged for special vehicles (Unimogs, tractors, trucks, busses, refrigerated vehicles etc.). Furthermore we charge a fee for trailers of all sorts additional to the vehicle.
- § 9 Camping – where permitted – is subject to a fee. Campsites may only be accessed with a valid admission ticket or in combination with an undamaged camping bracelet on each visitor's wrist. Visitors who fail to comply with this obligation will be liable to prosecution. The Nürburgring is located entirely in the Rhine-Ahr-Eifel landscape conservation area. This is why camping is only permitted in designated areas during specific periods. Upon entering the camping grounds, vehicles, trailers, camper vans and the like shall be checked on a selective basis and searched for prohibited items.
The following items are not allowed on the parking and camping sites:
 - Firearms, cut and thrust weapons, and all other weaponry
 - Saws, axes, and similar tools
 - Pyrotechnical equipment
 - Furniture and bulky waste
 - Lumbers and firewood
 - Palletted goods
 - motorised vehicles of any kind that do not comply with the German Road Traffic Act (StVO)Our security staff are authorised to confiscate items of this kind that are brought to the premises for the duration of the event. If they do so, they will hand out a receipt. The confiscated items will be returned during the periods printed on the receipt at the operations headquarters of Nuerburgring in building A.
- § 10 It is forbidden to dig any boundaries or holes in the ground.
- § 11 Private stands may only be erected with Layher scaffolding systems with a spectator platform no higher than 1.50 m (measured from the ground). Nürburgring reserves the right to have Layher stands/scaffolding dismantled if they are a hazard to other visitors or the racing. For reasons of stability (wind), putting up tarpaulins/banners to clad the Layher stands is prohibited. Self-made stands made of wood and other materials are generally prohibited and will be dismantled and disposed of by Nürburgring at the expense of the responsible party.



PARKING AND TEMPORARY CAMPING SITE REGULATIONS

Technical equipment to improve visibility, such as mobile elevated working platforms, mobile cranes and scissor lifts, are prohibited. This also applies to using such devices on parking lots and campsites. If this provision is violated, the equipment concerned will be removed from the premises at the expense of the responsible party.

- § 12 Please refrain from any of the actions listed below:
- Do not leave your engine running unnecessarily.
 - Refrain from any unnecessary vehicle movements on the site, in particular with quads, mopeds, scooters etc. This does not include travel to and from the site. Vehicles that are not street-legal (self-built) **and lawn mower tractors** are generally not allowed on the site.
 - All kinds of noise, e. g. through loud music systems. Quietness must be kept at night between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Music may only be played at a normal caravan/tent volume at all other times. The speakers of music systems in use must be adjusted so as not to disturb others nearby. Security staff may limit the maximum volume for the protection of local residents.
 - Live bands are generally prohibited from performing on the camping sites for reasons of noise control.
 - It is strictly forbidden to set off any kind of fireworks.
 - Camp fires must not be lit. Barbecue fires may only be lit in suitable containers.. In case of storm or other bad weather conditions , barbecuing may be forbidden. A barbecue in use may at no time be left unattended. Tipping coal on the ground to make it cool down is prohibited.
 - Refrain from cutting off or down any branches and trees. The party at fault will be liable for any damage.
- § 13 All waste must be collected separately in the appropriate bags and dropped off at one of the collection points on your departure. If you have paid a deposit for your waste this will be refunded at the times printed on the card. All waste including returnable bottles / - cans are the property of the Nürburgring. The collection of returnable bottles and the damage of the waste collection stations are strictly forbidden and will be prosecuted as an offense.
- § 14 All paths, constructions, and facilities of the parking and camping sites are to be kept clean and used carefully. Furthermore, entering the Grand-Prix-Track and the Nordschleife is forbidden. Willful littering and dirtying of the tracks and all other premises and belongings of the Nürburgring will be prosecuted.
- § 15 Chemical toilets from caravans or motor homes cannot be emptied on the premises of Nürburgring. They may not be emptied into the waste water system of Nürburgring.
- § 16 Pollution of waters is prohibited.
- § 17 Do not block any access and escape routes since we will otherwise have the vehicle towed away at the expense and risk of the vehicle owner. Please observe all signs and orders of the security personnel of the Nürburgring in this connection.
- § 18 Charges will be brought in case of damage to property such as fences, signs and the like. Painting the race tracks is prohibited and will be prosecuted as damage to property. Security staff are authorised to confiscate corresponding equipment (such as paint, brushes, paint rollers, spray cans, etc.) without compensation.
- § 19 Willful damage to any branches and trees on parking and camping sites as well adjoining premises is forbidden. Persons responsible for any damage will be prosecuted for vandalism.
- § 20 The temporary camping site may not be used for any activities other than its original purpose (e. g. commercial activities).
- § 21 The camping unit must be kept clean and tidy at all times by the camping guest. The Nürburgring is entitled to demand that any waste on and around the unit be removed.
- § 22 Camping units can be reserved only after prior consultation with those responsible at Nürburgring. Blocking (reserving) areas at the camping sites is generally prohibited. In the event of non-compliance, security staff are entitled to remove any barriers erected and confiscate the materials used without compensation.
- § 23 Barriers may not be climbed over for reasons of safety and landscape protection.
- § 24 The law for the protection of the youth is valid on all parking and camping sites.
- § 25 Other guests are to be considered.
- § 26 Guests must follow the orders of the security personnel of the Nürburgring.
- § 27 The Covid regulations of the respective current "Corona Bekämpfungsverordnung des Landes Rheinland-Pfalz" are valid.

Please help us with the implementation of these site regulations. Violations of and non-compliance with the regulations will lead to an immediate expulsion from the site. We reserve the right to bring charges in individual cases.
